Apprenticeships

Agriculturally we offer a four year apprenticeship in conjunction with Lackham or Reaseheath for the brighter candidates (www.reaseheath.ac.uk) in land based technology. This involves block release with students at Reaseheath, staying away at college during these periods which can be for up to six weeks. We are looking for 5 GCSEs at C grade or above.

The Vehicle Division offers four year apprenticeships for Service Technicians through two routes, either using the Land Rover Academy or Wiltshire College (www.wiltshire.ac.uk). Both courses lead to an NVQ Level 3 qualification. The apprenticeship programme is open to candidates who have achieved 5 or more GCSEs at C grade or above (it is preferable that they include Maths and English).

The Grasscare Division offers a four year block release apprenticeship in conjunction with South Worcestershire College (www.sworcs.ac.uk) in Worcestershire. Potential candidates should have grade C or above in the Sciences, Maths, and English. The apprenticeship leads to a City and Guilds qualification in land based engineering.

Our Crane Division offers a four year course in partnership with Avon Vale Training (www.avonvale.co.uk) leading to an NVQ Level 2 award in Engineering Operations. The course also includes block/day release training at Wiltshire College. Candidates would normally be expected to have achieved a significant number of GCSEs including Maths and English, although aptitude and desire for a genuine hands-on engineering career are just as important.
