LITHIUM SETS THE PACE AT SAPEY

Sapey Golf and Country Club near Worcester has always been a 'young' club - young in years, having been established as recently as 1990 - and with a young clientele.

The main 18 hole course and adjoining 9 hole course were set out by the Preece family on undulating land with beautiful views of the Malvern Hills. Over the years trees have grown and matured creating breath-taking vistas across the parkland course which, combined with water features and an excellent clubhouse and restaurant has made it one of the most popular golf courses in Worcestershire.

In 2017 the Preeces decided to retire and the club was sold to Wyldcrest Parks. Significant new investment has been announced which will bring new facilities to Sapey, as well as lodges in the grounds so people can stay for golf breaks. The highly playable par 3, 6,000-yard course also has a new general manager, Paul Hubner, who has great ambitions to bring some major tournaments to the club, as well as broadening appeal among young golfers who represent the future of the sport.

"Young players are often pressed for time," says Paul. "They have busy jobs and like to play a quick round of golf before or after work. Very much part of that is the convenience of having golf cars available to move around the course."

The new investment at Sapey has enabled Paul to replace the club's entire fleet of golf cars and, following discussions with Simon Bingham of T H WHITE Golf & Utility, he decided on what is probably the most advanced golf car on the market - the E-Z-GO RXV ELITE with lithium power. In

fact Paul was so impressed with the RXV ELITE's specification that he ordered 15 of them!

"The E-Z-GO RXV ELITE is closely based on the hugely popular lead-acid powered RXV golf car," explains Simon Bingham, "but E-Z-GO has teamed up with Samsung SDI to replace the lead-acid batteries with a zero-maintenance lithium battery system. Everything is literally sealed for life and the only

maintenance accessory you will ever need is a can of WD-40!"

With an astonishing 15-stone weight saving compared to the standard RXV, the RXV ELITE is 59 per cent more efficient. A full charge will deliver between 85 and 100 minutes running time and the lithium batteries can be charged on-the fly at any time - a 20 minute charge lifting the battery status to around 80 per cent. That means the cars can always be powered up and ready to go, regardless of the length of the golfing day. An advanced battery management system monitors efficiency, temperatures, state-of-charge, and the health of the lithium batteries which are covered by a 5-year unlimited amp-hour warranty, while the whole vehicle is covered by a 2-year warranty. RXV ELITE golf cars also benefit from a limited slip differential to eliminate wheel marks on the turf, as well as the patented

Intellibrake system which brings added safety by stopping the car automatically if the driver's feet are removed from the pedals.

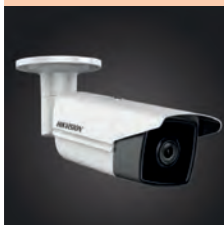

AN INTEGRATED SOLUTION TO FARM SECURITY

To assist in the fight against rural crime T H WHITE Energy, Fire & Security has designed a multi-camera smart CCTV system which will alert customers to intrusion and trespass on the farm.

To illustrate how the system would work our Energy, Fire & Security team has taken the case of a hypothetical farm, shown in the diagram below. In this scheme, five cameras cover key areas of the farm site. Potential intruders and trespassers are detected and, using state-of-the-art analytic software, notifications of activity are provided directly to the customer's PC or to any iOS or Android device using an app.

Cameras and smart analytics

The cameras are high definition Hikvision 'bullet' units, designed to perform well in bright or dull lighting. The default image is colour, and the cameras will continue to produce colour images, even in low light. But when light levels drop further, the cameras switch to producing monochrome images with the on-board infrared LEDs lighting the scene. Some of the cameras are designed to produce a general view of certain areas including coverage of the car park, while others are set up via the analytics software to focus on sensitive areas.

An Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) camera at the main entrance (1) captures registration numbers of vehicles coming and going from site. The software can then automatically check the recorded number plates to identify if any are 'blacklisted' so that notifications can be



sent to the customer.

A turret dome camera (2) is used to monitor the car park. A turret dome is used because the camera is in a prominent position and is more discreet than a bullet camera. These are preferred to standard domes when installed in an outdoor location because they are less affected by glare from housing or street lighting etc. Also, the infrared LEDs are positioned separately from the camera lens which draws insects and IR glare away from the camera lens.

For the farm shop a fisheye camera (3) is installed in a central position. These cameras have a clever lens which records the full 360° scene as a warped image, but up to four channels can be used to provide de-warped images. So, there are effectively four separate cameras running constantly even though there is only a single lens in a single housing. The 360° coverage also allows the customer to pan, tilt and zoom around the scene.

A 'line-crossing' detector is enabled on the bullet camera located at the entrance to the medium value storage barn (4). This will identify anyone crossing a 'virtual' line at the entrance to the unit at times when they would not be expected to be there, again generating a notification.

An intrusion zone feature is enabled on the bullet camera viewing the yard area outside the storage unit for high

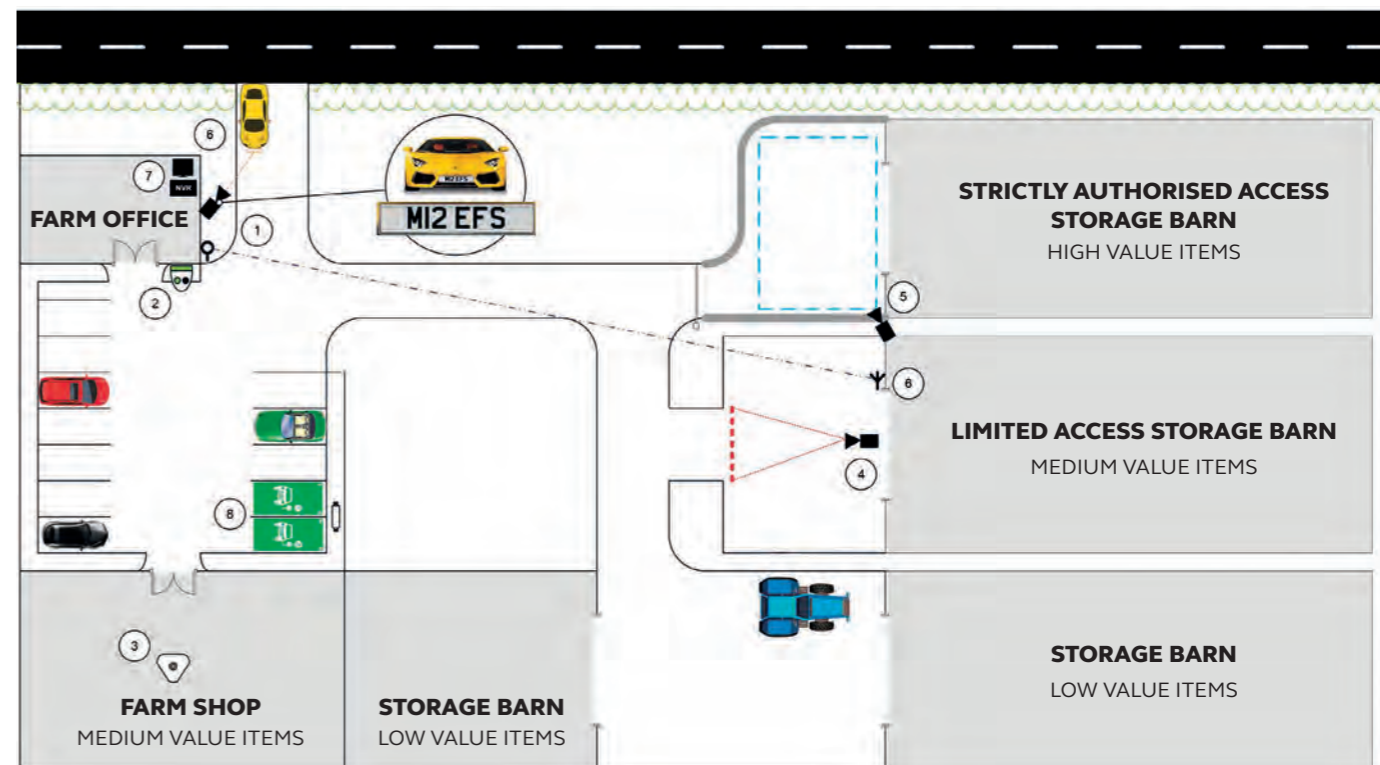
value items (5). A virtual area is drawn on the camera image and set up as an intrusion zone. If a person or vehicle is identified in this area outside permitted hours, a notification is generated.

Data transmission and recording

Data is sent over Cat6 cables (6) to and from the cameras where cable runs are practical. Two of the cameras are on a separate unit where cable runs aren't possible, so wireless data transmission is an excellent solution. In this example we are using a wireless transmitter and receiver connected to data switches to transmit the images back to the recording equipment.

The network video recorder (NVR, 7) is a unit that enables images to be viewed, processed and recorded. It is connected to the customer's network to allow the software to be used for both remote viewing and configuration of the system. The NVR features a monitor for viewing live or recorded images. This smart unit uses analytics to filter out false alarms and identify when a human target has crossed a line or entered a prohibited area. When that happens the NVR will send an alert to the customer who can react by viewing the footage or by going to investigate. An added extra in this example installation is the electric vehicle charging point (8).

THE BEST JUST GOT BETTER

Honda UK has launched its new flagship ATV, the exciting new 2020 TRX520 Foreman.

Following a research visit to the UK two years ago, the R&D team from Honda in Ohio listened carefully to what our customers wanted and went away to make it happen. The result is the excellent new TRX520FA6 Foreman.

The earlier version of this ATV first appeared in 2015 and this new model retains many of the same excellent features including independent suspension, hydraulic disc brakes, high/low range, power steering, difflock, 2/4 wheel drive, superb rider comfort and automatic transmission with optional

electric shift (ESP) – using no belts – with the ability to tow 600kg

So what's new about the 2020 model? Well, firstly engine capacity has been increased from 475cc to 518cc, for more power, torque and cleaner emissions. The luggage racks are better designed with new features and a 1.9 litre storage container with lid is now mounted within the front rack. There are improved brush guards and an all new front bumper. Added to that, the lighting has been improved.

Most significant of all though is the new reverse shift operation. On this model and 2020 TRX420 automatics, reverse is now engaged with a simple,



finger operated button; the response is instant, it can be selected at speeds of up to 3kph and it's so easy to use – especially on a cold morning with gloves on!

Another upgrade to the transmission mapping is the ability to override, shifting manually in auto without selecting ESP. The transmission drops back to auto after a few minutes.

We have ridden the new 520 and found it more responsive than the 2019 model with plenty of torque for towing. The all-important engine braking is really impressive too for safer downhill riding and we liked the new more purposeful look resulting from the subtle front bumper change.

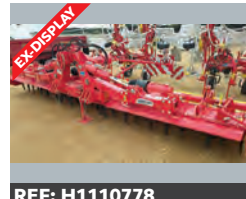

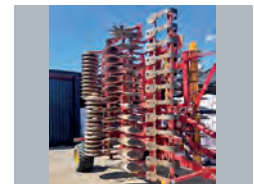
